- 1. Yearbook
 - Thank you to Danielle Correia for putting together the 2021/22 Yearbook!
 - Yearbooks have been delivered to students. If any family had ordered a Yearbook but have not yet received one please let Ashleigh know.
 - The PAC Executive voted to do a 2022/23 Yearbook. Families will be able to order the Yearbooks with their school photo orders. Cost TBD, PAC executive voted to lower the cost to make it more affordable for families in lieu of making profit.
- 2. Peak of the Market Farm to School
 - Delivery day and parent pick up day scheduled for Weds, Oct 5
 - Volunteers are required for:
 - Vegetable delivery & sorting Vegetables will be deliver to the school the afternoon of Oct 5th. Volunteers required to unload vegetables from delivery truck and help sort. Would need to be available on short notice between noon to 3pm. The delivery time will not be confirmed until Oct 5th
 - > Parent pick up Volunteers required to help hand out orders to parents from 3:30-5pm

Update for the Green Space Project (K. Renouf)

-Qualico Communities completed their portion of the project this summer (gifts in kind), which included The berm, the little hill with trees/benches in between the soccer fields and a new French drain by the south entrance. Super happy with the outcome. The snow fencing is staying up till winter/ground freeze to allow for grass/trees to take.

-Just approved a Green Drop contract to water the new trees on the little hill for this fall until fall 2023. Cost was \$1,134 and will come out of our Pembina Trails account.

-The new swings& climber from Blue Imp has a ship/delivery date of Oct.21/22 and should be installed this Fall 2022!!

-Bids to complete the rest of the project will occur in early 2023.

-This Fall, our playground committee will need to discuss plans/options for our outdoor acknowledgment to our donors for the project. I will be sending out an email about this at some point in October/November.
