

Safe Grad[™] Registration is now Open!

A group of parent/guardian volunteers has planned a night of fun, games, activities, and dancing to follow the Graduation Dinner at RBC Convention Centre on **June 24th**, **from 10pm – 3am**. A Safe Grad™ event is planned to organize an enjoyable and incident free graduation celebration, **separate from the formal dinner**.

The purpose of a Safe Grad™ program is to eliminate accidents and misfortune by promoting safe practices among graduates and avoid dangerous incidents with alcohol and drugs. Students must register to attend, and only attendees over 18 years of age will be allowed to purchase alcohol.

Steps to complete:

1.	Complete the on-line registration <u>before</u> returning this form to the school. Safe Grad representatives will be on-site at the school on May 17, 19, 26 and June 10 to answer questions, collect forms and cash or cheque payments.
2.	After completing registration, graduates, their guests and parents/guardians of both graduate and guest must complete, print, and <u>sign the attached Registration and Signatures form (2 pages)</u> and return it to school. In addition, a photocopy of student and guest ID must be attached to the form.
3.	If you have not already paid for safe grad, (through the fundraising 'opt out' \$58 payment), you must include \$20 per ticket with this form, or submit by e-transfer to MasseySafeGrad2022@gmail.com . Note: If paying by e-transfer please include the name of student and "safe grad ticket" in the message.

FAQ:

So, how does this whole day work? June 24th will be a busy day! Many grads will decide to dress up early in the day and visit the school, their middle school, local parks, the legislative grounds or other venues to take photos and commemorate the day. A nap in the late afternoon is a great idea!

Arrive for Grad Dinner, (register for this separately!), in all your finery, take photos with family and friends, enjoy a delicious meal, then take a break in the lobby while we switch over our space to start the Safe Grad party!

Check in with our Safe Grad registration team and get ready to dance the night away! When you are all partied out, let your designated ride home know to come and pick you up. Check out with our registration team and head for home with a bucket of memories to keep forever.

When and Where is Safe Grad? Safe Grad is at the same venue and in the same room as Grad Dinner, at the RBC Convention Centre in the York Ballroom, on June 24, from 10pm to 3am.

Can I change out of my suit/dress after dinner? No, all Safe Grad attendees must stay in the building and cannot leave for any reason between dinner and Safe Grad. A change of shoes can be brought, but no bags or backpacks are allowed, and clothing changes are not an option.

Can I bring a guest? Yes, one guest can attend Safe Grad with you. If they are not a Massey grade 12 graduating student, you need to include them in your registration details and purchase a ticket for them to attend.

Can I bring my own food/beverages? No, outside food/drinks are not allowed. Snacks will be available throughout the evening with pizza served at midnight. Pop and water service will be available all night. Alcohol will be available for purchase to guests over 18 years of age until 2am. Anyone caught bringing in outside alcohol, drugs, weapons or any other contraband will be required to have their ride come and pick them up immediately. No smoking or vaping is allowed. Don't cut a great evening short by making a bad decision. Security will be prominent and vigilant, and they know all the tricks.

Do I need to bring ID or money? Yes, ID is required to enter the event and will be checked at the registration table, between dinner and Safe Grad. Pop is \$2.50 and water is no charge. Alcohol is between \$8 and \$11 per drink, please plan accordingly.

How do I get home? An adult (over 18) must be named on your registration form and must be available to be contacted at any time during the event. They must enter the building and show ID to the registration team then sign you out before you may leave. No one will be allowed to leave without a verified ride home.

Can my ride also drive my friend/guest home? Yes, as long as they are listed on the registration form as the driver for the friend/guest.

Wait, when do I get my diploma? Convocation is on June 29th, from 1-5pm, back at the RBC Convention Centre. A totally separate event! You'll hear more from the school about this.
