## Admin Report

Question to PAC regarding phones in school:
Most students are bringing phones and keeping them in their bags instead of putting them in the class pouches (saying they left them at home but are keeping them in their backpacks), impacts use of phones for educational purposes, Snap chat is still going on and is negative, there is tracking of inappropriate use that is being tracked by Mr. Yong, Admin is asking PAC for advice on whether they should loosen up and allow students phones at lunch. The goal is to have students interacting and engaging personally. PAC's directive is to keep the status quo and not loosen the phone policy
