## 7. Principal/Vice Principal Report (Peggy/Calvin) -

- have been to all the feeder schools for grade 5's
- open house last week, all kids have registrations registrations are due this week and next, depending on when presentations were done (Potential Grade 6 Classes: English 2 to 3, French 4 classes), Division does not provide staffing for School of Choice (applications do not have to be approved), Parents need to consider catchment for French and English as they are not the same, extra classes also need arts, PE, etc
- there will be an increase in overall homerooms as grade 6's move to 7 as well
- family information evening: February 27 at 6:30 am and will be also streamed online and it will be recorded, phone usage and technology, also AI and how it can be incorporated, how to monitor phones with kids, issues now are more kids issues less online issues
- staffing update: Troy Taylor hired for Gr 8 Math and Science is hired until end of June or until the day before the incumbent returns; two EA's were hired in the past month and have extensive educational backgrounds but will need to certify for teaching in MB,
- festival du voyageur: next Wednesday Feb 21 school wide activity, pancake breakfast served by staff to students, through out there will be voyageur day activities, end the day with a gym riot, parents welcome to come volunteer for any part of the day
- renovations of washrooms began in December were supposed to be done in early January but are not finished, main washroom with issues is in the 200 hallway, single use washroom in 100 hallway is used more often, not flushing, smearing, and doors kicked in are issues, have tried only allowing kids go one at a time, tried locking the doors at recess times to have kids in the washroom when it is busier, can only stop it if kids alert admin (kids or parents can message Peggy or Calvin), could take the outside door down, another idea to have an adult outside the door and a student would have to sign in (mostly the 7/8's)
- 5 and 6's are having fewer issues and other students would bring forward the issues to be dealt with immediately
- Peggy and Calvin will talk to the Division and see what kids could be given for tasks in the washroom and help them develop social responsibility.
