COMMUNITY AND CITIZENSHIP AWARDS

University of Manitoba Chown Centennial Scholarship The Chown is an additional U of M entrance scholarship presented to an outstanding academic student who makes significant contributions to the school and/or community.

The FRC Achievement Award is presented to a student who lives the school motto INSPIRE, CREATE, ACHIEVE. This award recognizes a student's ability to demonstrate critical thinking, innovation, and adaptability to enhance their own learning and the experience of their members.

City Councillor Janice Lukes Community Involvement Award is presented to a student who has significant involvement in the school or community.

St. Norbert-Seine River Community Award Markus Chambers This award should be given to a student who is involved in making the community a better place. It could be activism, social programming or involvement and leadership.

The Henry G. Izatt Award is presented to a student who exemplifies good citizenship within the school and in the community while maintaining a high academic standing.

The Steinbach Credit Union Scholarship is presented to a graduating student who has had significant involvement in school and/or community and plans to pursue post-secondary education.

Fort Richmond MLA Award is presented to a graduating student who has demonstrated a commitment to social, economic, or environmental justice, and is engaged with the broader community, and who plans to pursue post-secondary studies.

LEADERSHIP AND SERVICE AWARDS

Burt Kroeker Centurion Spirit Award This award is presented to an enthusiastic leader who has contributed outstanding time and effort to school activities throughout high school.

The FRC Create Award is presented to a student who lives the school motto *Inspire, Create, Achieve*. This award is presented to a student who contributes to the school community of creative passions.

FRC Student of the Year Award is presented to the student who, along with academic achievement and leadership qualities, has participated in various school activities and exemplified the centurion spirit.

The Pembina Trails School Division Citizenship Award This award will recognize the recipient's outstanding display of genuine concern for the improvement of the human condition demonstrated through leadership and school and community activities.

Winnipeg South Member of Parliamentary Leadership Award: Terry Duguid Member of Parliament Award is presented to a graduating student in recognition of consistent and outstanding

dedication to student leadership and an interest in science and innovation. This commitment can be demonstrated in areas such as: school leadership, volunteer activities, mentorship of peers, and dedication to the advancement of the community. This award is designed to recognize the achievements of youth who are determined to make a difference and help them realize their goals.

Pembina Trails School Division General Award of Academic Excellence of Citizenship Award is presented to a student with significant involvement in the school and community. This student has strong leadership and citizenship skills and an excellent academic standing.

Kirsten And Robbie Schaldemose Memorial Scholarship is presented to a student who has overcome adversity and shows compassion for others.

Math/ Science: Jerry Oster Bursary is awarded to a student who has a keen interest in math and science has demonstrated financial need and plans to pursue post-secondary studies in the coming year.

Ted Greenberg Memorial Award Pembina Trails Teacher Association Scholarship is presented to a student planning to enter the faculty of education. This student will demonstrate strong citizenship qualities, participation in volunteer community work with children and a positive attitude and contribution towards the school community. An essay is required as part of this application.

The Fort Garry Rotary Club Award is presented to a student who has community involvement and volunteered with Rotary. Good academic standing and plans to go to post-secondary. Please list involvement with the Rotary Club.

CUPE Local 4588 Memorial Scholarship is presented to a son daughter or grandchild of a member of CUPE local who best combines academic excellence with extracurricular activities in the school and the community.

Educational Assistance Pembina Trails Pat McDonald Scholarship is presented to a student who makes significant contributions to school and community and whose parent is a member of the EAPT.

Manitoba Institute of Trades and Technology Entrance Scholarship- awarded to a student who has maintained high academic achievement and plans to attend MITT immediately after graduation.

The Red River Partners and Education Scholarship is presented to a student who has maintained high academic achievement and plans to attend Red River college as a full-time student immediately after graduation.

Karen Kochan Scholarship These four awards were developed by Karen Kochan to support motivated young women as they pursue post-secondary education. This fund will support women with financial need who are looking to reach their goals through the pursuit of postsecondary education.

Bammeke Family Aspiring Entrepreneur Scholarship - Student who has successfully completed 2 or more business courses (Minimum: 75%) Enrolled or planning to enroll in post-secondary work or studies with a major in business, finance, marketing, economics, management or a related field. BIPOC student who is entrepreneurial or business-savvy and demonstrates strong academic performance — someone already showing signs of becoming a future leader. Attends and engages in class learning 80% of the time (min).
