ARTZPALOOZA - Mme Broughton and Mme Tessa are pleased to announce that Artspalooza 2023 is approaching for all our grade 7 students. This annual event of music and art making will take place January 27th and 28th and will feature guest artists, clinicians, workshops, and fun!

PE AT EVA HAS MOVED OUTDOORS Double periods in Physical Education have been added to the schedule to allow programming for outdoor winter activities such as skating, hockey, skiing, snowshoeing, and tobogganing. In addition to reducing time indoors and improving safety, this is to encourage active living as well as physical and mental wellbeing during the winter months and during this phase of the pandemic. The PE teachers sent a schedule weekly to let families know in advance what your child will be doing each day in PE so that they may dress for the weather and bring any extra equipment, as necessary. Equipment must be taken home each evening as there is no room to store it in classrooms over night.

Continued Professional Learning: Our next professional learning date is scheduled for Friday February 3. This time is dedicated to professional learning that centers student assessment.

Cohort Connections and Monthly Assemblies: Students continue to participate in monthly cohort connection activities to build community and a sense of belonging, even as we are apart. Our fourth experience was a school wide tin-can curling event! The next date for *Connexion en cohort* is Monday, January 23. This is aligned with our school plan goal of engaging students in their learning both inside and outside the classroom. Student-led monthly assemblies are held on TEAMS each month and allow students in all different spaces to share broadly with the whole school community.

Located at Pembina Trails Collegiate, the newest high school in Pembina Trails, the environment supports a sense of independence, professionalism and collaboration.
