Nutrition Break / Lunch Program

Nutrition Break:

- Grades K-5 Nutrition Break will occur directly before or after the morning recess. Please send a healthy snack for this break.
- Grade 6-8 students are encouraged to have a healthy snack during locker break at 10:45. Please send a healthy snack for this break.
- Our nutrition program will offer snacks to students in need.

Lunch Program:

- To stay at the school for the lunch hour, students must be **enrolled and have paid for** our lunch program. The fees allow us to hire outside staff to supervise students as school teaching staff, by contract, have a duty-free lunch hour.
- Lunch Program registration and fees will take place via Permission Click:

Walking Field Trips - Year-long Permission

Given the impromptu nature of walking field trips, General Byng is seeking, in advance, informed consent for your child to participate. Rather than sending home a separate permission form for each walking field trip, please complete the linked consent form which will cover your child's walking field trips for the entire school year.

Smudging

Smudging is a tradition, common to many First Nations, which involves the burning of one or more medicines gathered from the earth. The four sacred medicines used in First Nations' ceremonies are tobacco, sage, cedar, and sweetgrass. The most common medicines used in a

smudge are sweetgrass, sage, and cedar. Smudging has been passed down from generation to generation. Smudging allows people to stop, slow down, and become mindful and centered. This allows people to remember, connect, and be grounded in the event, task, or purpose at hand. Smudging also allows people to let go of negative feelings and thoughts. Letting go of things that inhibit a person from being balanced and focused comes from the feeling of being calm and safe while smudging.

The Pembina Trails School Division has developed procedures which will be followed for smudging with staff and students in schools. Participation in smudging is always voluntary and requires parent/guardian permission. Smudging is done in a designated area(s) at the school and any school sanctioned events.

Students must have signed consent to participate in smudging at school. By signing the Permission Click form below, students will have permission to participate in smudging in a designated area of the school and any school sanctioned events.

Building Access, Entrance and Exit Information

- All school doors will be locked during the day.
- Visitors must enter through the front door. Please ring the doorbell located on the wall to the right of the main doors to be granted access.
- Before and After School: Please drop off your child between 9:00 and 9:10 AM to ensure your child is in their class for 9:20 AM. Dismissal pick-up is 3:55 PM daily. There is no before or after school supervision.
- Students can enter the school at the 9:10 AM bell and should enter through the following doors:

Daycare Entrance (back doors by the parking lot): Kindergarten – Gr. 4

Garden Doors (by the play structure):
 Grade 5 and 6

Front Doors (main door off Beaumont Street): Grade 7 and 8

• Parents and guardians must wait outside when dropping off or picking up their child.

If you are driving your child/ren to school, we ask that you follow our procedures:

Please use Daniel Street and NOT Beaumont Street. Beaumont is extremely busy and hosts both Winnipeg Transit and Divisional Buses. We want to be courteous of our neighbours.

- Please travel south on Daniel Street to drop off your child/ren.
- Please do not park in the STOP, DROP and GO! drop zone on Daniel Street south of the back lane. We ask that you leave 3 car lengths for cars to pull in, drop their child/ren off safely, and resume driving south on Daniel Street.
- We must remain mindful that Daniel Street is used by the entire community therefore
 please do not stop on the north bound side of Daniel Street. The north bound side of
 Daniel Street is a "no stopping zone" and is extremely dangerous and will become
 increasingly dangerous as the winter weather rolls in.

- Please have your child exit the curb side (passenger side) back door where our staff/student Welcome Team will welcome them and assist your child in exiting the vehicle by closing the door behind them.
- Pull back out onto south bound Daniel Street and enjoy your day!

NOTE:

- The back lane is one-way traffic between the hours of 8:30 AM to 9:30 AM and 3:30 PM to 4:30 PM.
- Access to the back lane is only available between 9:30 AM and 3:30 PM.
- Only General Byng staff, Prairie Children's Daycare staff and families will be granted access to the back lane between the hours of 8:30 AM and 9:30 AM.
- Please be mindful of the City of Winnipeg sign that restricts access via Beaumont Street into the back lane. The City is updating the sign to read between the hours of 8:30 AM to 9:30 AM and 3:30 PM to 4:30 PM to accommodate our new school hours. Reminder our neighbours also may need to exit their homes during these times.



- Walking and Biking: We have the good fortune for our families to live in this accessible community. We encourage families to walk or bike to and from school. Please ensure bikes are locked up on the bike rack. Let the office staff know if you need to borrow a lock or tire pump. We recommend a strong U-LOCK for your bicycle.
- If you would like to **enroll your Grade 1-6 child in our WALKING School Bus.** Staff members will meet students at a designated location and time and escort them to school in the morning and then return with them to the same location after school. Please use the following link to register your child. Registration closes on day, September 4th at midnight. Absences and Late Arrivals

- If a student will be away from school, please use Edsby to submit their absence. Or, call the school office (204-452-3040). If you are unable to use Edsby, please email gbattendance@pembinatrails.ca.
- If a student is late for school (arriving after 9:20 AM or in the afternoon after 1:20 PM), the student is to come to the main school doors to access the building. Please ring the doorbell as the school doors will be locked. *Do not use the doorbell at the parking lot door – this is for the daycare, not the school.

Lunch Hour Breakdown:

Students will have 30 minutes for eating lunch and 30 minutes outdoors.

Students MUST be enrolled and fees paid to stay on school grounds for the lunch hour.

Grade 1-6 students must remain on property during lunch hour.

Grade 7 and 8 students enrolled and wanting to leave school grounds on a particular day must have permission granted by guardian when they enroll in the program (see <u>Lunch Program Registration and Fees</u>).

**Exception: students who are signed up for lunch hour clubs, may stay for the club even if they are NOT enrolled in the program.
