Lunch Program / Nutrition Break

Nutrition Break:

- Grades K-5 Nutrition Break will occur directly before or after the morning recess. Please send a healthy snack for this break.
- Grade 6-8 students are encouraged to have a healthy snack during locker break at 10:45.

Lunch Program:

- Lunch program registration and fees will take place via Permission Click:

- Students not attending General Byng's Lunch Program must be off school grounds from 12:15-1:15.

General Lunch Hour Information:

- The sharing of food/snacks is prohibited.
- General Byng is a peanut and nut aware school. Please attempt to provide lunches and snacks that are nut free.

Reminder: Students not attending General Byng's Lunch Program must be off school grounds from 12:15-1:15.

Building Access, Entrance and Exit Information

- All school doors will be locked during the day.
- Visitors must enter through the front door. Please ring the doorbell located on the wall to the right of the main doors to be granted access.
- Before and After School: Please drop off your child between 9:05 and 9:15 AM to ensure your child is in their class for 9:20 AM. Dismissal pick-up is 3:55 PM daily.
- Students can enter the school at the 9:10 AM bell and should enter through the following doors:

Daycare Entrance: Kindergarten and Grade 1-3

Garden Doors: Grade 4-6 Front Doors: Grade 7 and 8

Parents and guardians must wait outside when dropping off or picking up their child.


If you are driving your child/ren to school, we ask that you follow our procedures:

Please travel south on Daniel Street to drop off your child/ren.

- Please do not park in the STOP, DROP and GO! drop zone on Daniel Street south of the back lane. We ask that you leave 3 car lengths for cars to pull in, drop their child/ren off safely, and resume driving south on Daniel Street.
- We must remain mindful that Daniel Street is used by the entire community therefore please do not stop on the north bound side of Daniel Street. The north bound side of Daniel Street is a "no stopping zone" and is extremely dangerous and will become increasingly dangerous as the winter weather rolls in.
- Please have your child exit the curb side (passenger side) back door where our staff/student Welcome Team will welcome them and assist your child in exiting the vehicle by closing the door behind them.
- Pull back out onto south bound Daniel Street and enjoy your day!

NOTE:

- The back lane is one-way traffic between the hours of 8:30 AM to 9:30 AM and 3:30 PM to 4:30 PM.
- Access to the back lane is only available between 9:30 AM and 3:30 PM.
- Only General Byng staff, Prairie Children's Daycare staff and families will be granted access to the back lane between the hours of 8:30 AM and 9:30 AM.
- Please be mindful of the City of Winnipeg sign that restricts access via Beaumont Street into the back lane. The City is updating the sign to read between the hours of 8:30 AM to 9:30 AM and 3:30 PM to 4:30 PM to accommodate our new school hours. Reminder our neighbours also may need to exit their homes during these times.



- **Walking and Biking:** We have the good fortune for our families to live in this accessible community. We encourage families to walk or bike to and from school. Please ensure bikes are locked up on the bike rack. Let the office staff know if you need to borrow a lock or tire pump. We recommend a strong U-LOCK for your bicycle.
- If you would like to **enroll your Grade 1-6 child in our WALKING Student Bus**. Staff members will meet students at a designated location and time and escort them to school in the morning and then return with them to the same location after school.

There is one muster point for pick up and drop off on each route. We will add stops along the route with designated times once we have a finalized list of participants.

Absences and Late Arrivals

- If a student is late for school (arriving after 9:20 AM or in the afternoon after 1:20 PM), the student is to come to the main school doors to access the building. Please ring the doorbell as the school doors will be locked.

School Supplies, Lockers and Cubbies

• School supplies have been purchased and will be given to students in Kindergarten through Grade 8 during the first week of classes.

Please send the following items with your child:

- o a backpack for materials from home
- o a labelled water bottle
- Grades K-5 an extra set of clothing in case of accidents and weather. Labelled in a ziplock bag – this should be kept in their backpack.
- o Grades K-5 a pair of indoor runners
- Grades 3-8 Physical Education: drawstring bag, one pair of gym shorts, one t-shirt, and a pair of non-marking runners

Pembina Trails Guidelines on Personal Mobil Devices (PMDs)

Personal Mobile Devices (PMDs): Personal Mobile Devices may include, but are not limited to, any piece of lightweight electronically powered equipment. These devices are typically consumer electronic devices capable of communications, data processing and/or utility. Examples range from hand-held lightweight electronic devices such as tablets, e-readers and smart phones to small devices such as MP3 players, smart watches and electronic toys."

Pembina Trails Guidelines on Personal Mobile Devices (PMDs)

Early/Middle Years (Grades K-8)

- Pembina Trails: Students are not permitted to use a Personal Mobile Device (PMD) while on school premises during the school day. These grades are considered PMD-free learning environments. If a student requires the use of a PMD for notification to administer medication or has additional health-related concerns, accommodation must be provided by school administration.
- Students are encouraged to keep their PMDs at home. If brought to school PMDs cannot be kept on self. Schools will provide specific direction regarding storage.
