## PEMBINA TRAILS LEADERSHIP COMMUNITY (PTLC)

- 1. PTLC will operate with five standing councils as follows:
  - Early Years
  - Middle Years
  - Senior Years
  - French Immersion
  - Admin Professional Development
- 2. The chairperson for each Council will be determined by the Council membership and will sit for one year.
- 3. Council meetings should not exceed a half-day. Approximately 6-8 meetings will be held throughout the school year.
- 4. The chair of the Council will set the agenda and ensure that minutes are kept for each meeting.
- 5. Agenda items will be received from the following sources:
  - Council Members
  - Senior Administration Team (SAT)
  - · Directors, Coordinators, and Consultants
  - Yearly Priority Tasks
- 6. Councils are to identify priority tasks or objectives and establish plans-of- action to address them.
- 7. Councils are to regularly report to PTLC, i.e. Agenda Items
- 8. Year-End Reports are to be submitted to PTLC at the May or June meeting and will be structured as follows:
  - Members
  - Meeting Dates
  - Tasks Completed
  - Recommendations for the following year
