#### **CLOSING OF OUR SECOND YEAR AT PTC!**

#### **Dear PTC Students and Families,**

As the 2024-25 school year draws to a close, it's hard to believe we are at the end of year two. We want to take this opportunity to share important information as we wrap up one year and prepare for the next. We are immensely proud to have embarked on this journey with you all. Your courage and kindness as a community of students and families has been truly inspiring. Our dream of hosting our first ever convocation became a reality, Congratulations to the inaugural class of 2025 graduates - you did it! While the road hasn't always been smooth, we've learned valuable lessons along the way, and we remain committed to building upon the beautiful pathways we've collectively created, thanks to a school model that wholeheartedly embraces each child and paves innovative pathways for our students. **Please note:** 

- 1. Timetable Updates: We have not provided paper copies of timetables as this did not work efficiently this past year. We learnt from this. You will see your timetable mid August when our new data is rolled over for the upcoming year in Edsby. If you need to adjust your timetable please see below, We will not make timetable changes to be with peers or to be with certain teachers. We cannot facilitate these wishes, being in high school allows you to build new relationships with teachers and with new peers preparing you for life after high school. There will be **ONE appointment allowed per student to a maximum of 20 minutes**. With approx. 1350 students next year, we cannot facilitate more than one appointment. You will **Edsby message** your student support teacher (advisor) and they will provide you with one 20 minute appointment. There is no flexibility with the date and time of this appointment.
  - a. **Grade 9 students** your family will receive an email with the name of your student support teacher (advisor) this week. During **August 25-28** if you require a conversation about your timetable you need to Edsby message your advisor. They will then give you a date and time to come in for one 20 minute appointment.
  - b. **Grade 10 students** During **September 3-12** if you require a conversation about your timetable you need to Edsby message your advisor. They will then give you a date and time to come in for one 20 minute appointment.
  - c. **Grade 11 students** During **September 3-12** if you require a conversation about your timetable you need to Edsby message your advisor. They will then give you a date and time to come in for one 20 minute appointment.
- d. Grade 12 students During August 25-28 if you require a conversation about your timetable you need to Edsby message your advisor. They will then give you a date and time to come in for one 20 minute appointment. \*Any students that could not make it in during August 25-28 can make an appointment between September 3-12 but priority will be given to the grades as listed above. Please remember one appointment only.



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- Address Changes/Schools of Choice: If you move out of the PTC catchment area during the summer, please be aware that you will need to attend your catchment school based on your new address. Our school is growing, and this adjustment ensures that everyone is accommodated appropriately. Keep in mind that we have limited space in certain grades, and we've accepted a minimum number of schools of choice applicants for the 2025-26 school year.
