VANDALISM

Vandalism is the willful, malicious abuse, destruction, defacing and/or theft of Division property. Persons who willfully or maliciously destroy Division property through vandalism or arson or who create a hazard to the safety of other people on school property may be referred to the Winnipeg Police Department. Vandalism also includes the knowing and unauthorized use, alteration, damage or destruction of any computer, computer system, software, program or computerized data. Students who vandalize Division property will be subject to the Divisional Standard of Behaviour.

Every citizen of the Division, students and staff are urged by the Board to cooperate in reporting any incidents of vandalism to Division property and the name of the person or persons believed to be responsible.

The Superintendent, Principal or designate is required to file a Theft/Vandalism/Burglary Incident Report, ECAC-E with the Human Resources and Facilities & Operations Departments. Where appropriate, the Superintendent, Principal or designate is required to make a report of the incident to the Winnipeg Police Department.

It is the policy of the Board to investigate such acts and to seek restitution from persons found to have committed such acts.
