Teachers, as professionals, continuously assess and adjust the pace and methods of teaching required for their classes to reach the curricular outcomes, making it difficult to gauge what work will be covered during extended absences. In addition, replication of the rich class discussions and group work that take place at school on a daily basis is impossible.

We hope that you and your family take the opportunity to connect with your child's learning and teach them essential life skills as you all enjoy some memorable times together.
