24	HB pencils (<i>Staedtler, Dixon or Ticonderoga</i>). (Please send <i>real wood pencils</i> and nothing decorative as they break easily and damage pencil sharpeners)
1	24 pack sharpened pencil crayons (<i>Crayola or Laurentian</i>)
1	Package large-tipped Crayola markers , appx 16-pack
5	Highlighters (1 each of yellow, blue, pink, orange and green)
4	White vinyl erasers
2	Blue pens
2	Black pens
1	Good quality pair of blunt-tipped scissors
2	Glue sticks
8	Fine-tipped Expo or Staples brand whiteboard markers (at least two different colours) (<i>You can send 4 and keep 4 at home for when your child needs to replace them</i>)
2	Black Sharpie markers
1	Pencil sharpener (with receptacle to catch shavings, <i>Staedtler brand preferred</i>)
1	Zippered pencil case or pencil box
1	2” binder (no zippers)
1	Package of 5 binder dividers
1	Plastic duotang , any colour
2	Hilroy scribblers (40 pages , approx. 27.6 x 21.3 cm, <i>one pink, one blue, no coils please!</i>)
1	Hilroy half-dotted rule exercise book , 72 pages, <i>green</i> (pages are half plain and half lined)
1	Sketchbook for sketching and drawing (<i>Dollar-store quality is fine</i>)
