General Supply List Grade 6 French Immersion 2023-2024

This year, teachers will be collecting supply fees to enable class sets of certain items to be purchased by the school and stored in classrooms. This will enable us to take advantage of our school discounts and ensure availability of supplies when needed. The supply list below is designated as a “start” for this year. Some supplies (example: pencils, pens, paper) will need to be replenished during the year. It is best to keep extra supplies at home until needed to avoid loss or damage. Supplies from the previous school year are very acceptable to be used again. Where possible, please label the supplies with your child’s name.

A permission click will be sent home in the fall to collect the supply fee as well as the regular student fee. The student fee is used to help subsidize the cost of field trips and in class programming throughout the year.

Band Students:

Gym Supplies: The Physical Education team noticed very little interruption to engagement in class when students did not change during the pandemic period. Therefore, changing for physical education is no longer mandatory. The largest barrier to participation in physical education classes is students who did not have proper footwear. Track shoes or running shoes allow your child to be prepared to be active while staying safe. There are two options:

Option A: Wear shoes/runners to school on the days of physical education class.

Option B: Wear outdoor choice of footwear to school and bring track shoes/runners to change for physical education class. These shoes can be stored in lockers.

Practical Arts Students:

The general supplies are provided to complete the courses. Extra supplies for special projects have a nominal cost.

Face Masks: Face masks are now considered optional.
