

INDEPENDENT SCHOOLING/HOME SCHOOLING

The Division recognizes the rights of parents to register their children in independent schools or to home school their children.

Any resident parent choosing independent or home schooling must recognize the following:

- It is the parent's responsibility to satisfy the attendance requirements for school attendance. Parents wishing to home school must register their children with the Home Schooling Office of Manitoba Education and make all required reports to the Minister of Education or designate.
- The Division assumes no responsibility for the outcomes of enrollment in independent schooling or home schooling.
- The Division retains the right to assess any student who has been registered in an independent school or home schooled and wishes to return to or be placed in the Division. Placement in an appropriate program will be based upon the judgments of Division employees.
- The Division reserves the right to deny requests of parents of home schooled students to participate in school based programs (academic and extra-curricular) to supplement home schooling.
- Division sponsored assessment programs and activities shall not be available to students participating in any form of independent schooling.
- The Division accepts no obligation to provide educational materials to students enrolled in an independent school or students being home schooled.
