

REVIEW AND APPROVAL OF COMMUNITY PROGRAMS/MATERIALS

Organizations, institutions, and individuals at times develop programs/materials that are offered to schools for free or inexpensively for use in instruction. As a general rule, these materials present a particular point of view, and extreme care must be exercised in evaluating and using them.

The use of such resources must have the approval of the principal. Requests to provide community programs/materials to more than one school shall be directed to the Assistant Superintendent – Program.

Such materials must be selected according to the Instructional Resources and Materials Selection Policy, IJ.
