

POLITICAL SPEAKERS

The Division will permit present and former leaders of Provincial and Federal political parties and the local Member of Parliament and/or Member of the Legislative Assembly or candidates for such offices to speak to students during school hours, subject to the following:

That the person:

- has shared the purpose of the presentation with the Principal in advance;
- has the approval of the Principal; and
- that student attendance at such a presentation is on a voluntary basis.

During an election campaign, if one candidate is afforded the opportunity to students, efforts will be made to have all candidates appear at the same time. During such events the length of the presentation will be at the Principal's discretion.

Teachers may utilize elected representatives as resource people in accordance with policies IMB Teaching Controversial/Sensitive Issues and IMC Controversial Speakers.
