WINTER WEAR

Please ensure your child is prepared for cold weather. And slushy weather as the temperatures rise and fall. A spare change of clothes (Including socks) is helpful for students Kindergarten to Grade 4.

If you are in need of any winter wear, please contact our main office and we will be happy to support you.

DROP-OFF and PICK-UP

As the weather turns it is imperative to remember our drop-off and pick-up protocols.

Our back lane is becoming increasingly dangerous for students at the end of the day. If you are entering the back lane, please do not block our neighbouring driveways or garages. We also ask that you meet your child and help them cross the back lane. Many students have been running out into the lane. We continue to monitor this and if we deem necessary, we may close the back lane after school or implement a more strict safety driven pick up protocol.

Drop-off on Daniel Street must happen at the entrance to the back lane. **The back lane is CLOSED and only open to staff and Day Care families.** Students dropped off at the back lane entrance use the STOP, DROP, and GO philosophy and students can walk through the path in the back field to remain safe from street traffic.

We also ask that you drop students off as close to 9:10 as possible. We do not have supervision duty before 9:10 and students must remain outdoors until the entry bell goes at 9:10 AM.

Pick-Up must happen at school dismissal time: 3:55 PM. If you are picking up your child earlier than 3:55, please contact the main office and we will have them ready at the main office.

OUTDOOR BELLS

Our outdoor bells continue to give us problems. The division is working with us to fix them. Until then, our staff will continue to support students by opening doors at the designated times to ensure students can enter the school and get to classes on time. Thank you for your continued patience.
