

Policy: JFAB

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ADMISSION OF NON-RESIDENT STUDENTS

This policy is applicable to the admission of students whose parents or legal guardians reside outside the Division, but are Canadian citizens or permanent residents residing in Canada. Admission of non-residents residing in Manitoba is governed by the Province of Manitoba School of Choice regulation. International students, exchange students, students accompanying parents or legal guardians who are not Canadian citizens or permanent residents, non-permanent residents, and Canadian citizens or permanent residents whose parents or legal guardians reside outside of Canada are subject to the provisions of policy JFABB.

Admission of a non-resident student will only be accepted provided one of the Request for Admission forms (JFAB-E-1 or JFAB-E-2 under construction) has been completed and approved by the Principal and forwarded to the Secretary-Treasurer. Acceptance is conditional upon payment of non-resident fees or alternative arrangements i.e. waiving of non-resident fees.

Waiving of Non-Resident Fees

The Division may give consideration to the waiving of non-resident fees for students whose parents reside outside the Division as defined in the Public Schools Act in accordance with the attached regulation. Where the Superintendent has denied the waiving of non-resident fees, the parent may appeal to the Board in writing.

The admission and continuance of a student in the Division shall be subject to compliance with the Division's Standard of Behaviour.
