## STUDENT CONDUCT ON SCHOOL BUSES

The following additional expectations for student conduct shall apply during the use of school buses:

- 1. Pupils shall stand well back from the curb while awaiting the arrival of the bus.
- 2. Pupils shall enter the bus in an orderly fashion and go directly to a seat and remain seated until the destination is reached.
- 3. Pupils shall keep their hands, arms, and heads inside the bus.
- 4. Loud, boisterous behaviour or profane language shall not be tolerated.
- 5. No windows or doors will be opened or closed except by permission or the driver.
- 6. No pupils shall enter or leave the bus until it has come to a full stop and the door has been opened by the driver.
- 7. Pupils shall not handle any of the safety equipment of the bus.
- 8. There shall be no smoking at anytime on school buses.
- 9. Directions given by the driver shall be followed.
- 10. "No school bus, while transporting children, shall be used to carry any animal, firearm, explosive, flammable liquid, or anything of a dangerous or objectionable nature, or any article likely to endanger the safety of the passengers." P.S.A. Reg. P250-465/88 4(k)

The Principal or designate and the driver shall assume joint responsibility for deciding on the acceptability of articles to be carried on the bus.
