

## STUDENT CONDUCT ON SCHOOL BUSES

Whenever student transportation is provided, the buses used are considered to be extensions of the classroom and the expectations for student conduct on such buses shall be consistent with those identified in *The Public Schools Act*, its regulations, the expectations established for classroom behaviour and the expectations identified in JICC-R.

Students are under the supervision of and responsible to the bus driver when a teacher is not present. The driver of a school bus shall report to the Principal any misconduct of pupils while entering, leaving, or being conveyed in a school bus under the driver's charge.

Students are accountable to the Principal for their behaviour when on the bus.
