Can I refuse to be a part of the Student Threat Assessment process?

It is important for all parties to engage in the process. However, if for some reason there is a reluctance to participate in the process, by the threat maker or parent/guardian, the Threat Assessment process will continue in order to ensure a safe and caring learning environment.

What is a Threat Assessment Team?

Each school has a Threat Assessment Team which is multidisciplinary. The team may include Principal, Vice-Principal, School Social Worker, School Psychologist, Counsellor and Police.

What is the Main Purpose of a Threat Assessment?

- To be proactive in developing an intervention plan that the emotional and physical safety of the threat maker. To promote the emotional and physical safety of all.

What happens in a Student Threat Assessment?

Once the team has been activated, interviews may be held with the student(s), the threat maker, parents and staff to determine the level of risk and a verilop an approximate response to the incident. Intervention plans will be developed and shared with parents, staff and students as required.
