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STUDENT SAFETY PATROLS

The Division believes that the safety of students travelling to and from school is the shared responsibility of: parents/guardians, citizens, school personnel, the Division, the Winnipeg Police Service and the City of Winnipeg, as well as the students themselves. The Division, in response to Section 48 (1) (u) of The Public Schools Act, authorizes the School Administrators or designates of schools with K – 6 students to organize and use student safety patrols at locations adjacent to school property at times to be determined by the School Administrator or designate.

Patrol members should be selected for their leadership and reliability. Their service must be voluntary and their participation subject to the written consent of a parent/guardian. Patrollers shall serve at the discretion of the School Administrator or designate.

Training for each school's supervisors, patrol captains, and patrollers shall be conducted by the Winnipeg Police Service School Resource Unit.

Adults may be assigned to those intersections and street crossings where it is deemed that student safety patrols would be inadequate by reason of distance from the school, traffic, or other circumstances.
