- Responses to surveys or other means; and
- Service on school councils, booster organizations or other support associations at the school or Division level.

The Board and its administration will give the public's advice careful consideration. In evaluating such advice, the Board's overriding concern will be for its statutory responsibility to provide programs and facilities to support educational activities within the capacity of the available financial resources.
