PUBLIC GIFTS/DONATIONS TO SCHOOLS

Basic Principles:

- 1. Gifts/donations can be used as a source of revenue to fund materials and support personnel for regular education and supplementary programs.
- 2. Gifts/donations received shall in no way dictate the direction of Division programs, nor hamper the objective evaluation of Division programs.
- 3. All funds received, apart from those directed to the PTESF, shall be under the control and supervision of the superintendent and the administrative staff.
- 4. The Board reserves the right to turn down any outside funds not consistent with the objectives and policies of the Pembina Trails School Division.
- 5. When private donations are used to provide, maintain, or enhance school programs, the Division will be under no obligation to continue the same level of programming in subsequent years, or if the outside funding is discontinued or diminished.
- 6. Donations shall not be used to fund regular teaching positions.
- 7. The contribution of specific items may be allowed. The Superintendent shall cause such contributions to be reviewed or inspected regarding their propriety and applicability. The decision to accept or reject the proposed contribution is to be made by the Superintendent or designate.
- 8. Periodic reports of activities resulting from gifts, grants or bequests shall be given to the Board by the superintendent and his staff, including donations made to the PTESF.
