The Manitoba Teachers' Society and the Manitoba School Boards Association have developed a one-day workshop for training employees who are WSH Committee Members or WSH representatives. Co-Chairs, Custodians, Senior Administrators, Trustees, Principals, teachers, and non-teachers (CUPE, MANTE, etc.) are encouraged to attend.

One (1) training session will be offered per region, with the exception of Metro. All Metro sessions will be hosted and organized by MTS. Dates will fill up quickly, so please book as soon as possible.

This workshop counts as one day towards the mandatory two days of Workplace Safety and Health committee member training to be funded by the employer. Updated Memorandum and Registration forms will be sent out

The one-day workshop will cover the following three topics:

- 1. "Workplace Safety and Health A School Perspective" (Tammy Hodgins-Rector, MTS) This session will review the legislation and responsibilities of staff, principals/supervisors, and the employer related to workplace safety and health. It also includes new information on recent statistics collected by MTS, recent trends, legislation updates and scenarios.
- 2. "Back to Basics: A refresher course in Managing Safety Incidents" (Leonard Zdrill, MSBA) Leonard will provide a stripped down review of the fundamental process for reporting, investigation, correcting and dispensing of safety concerns, injuries, and incidents. A facilitated discussion around what the process is in different school divisions and an opportunity to share ideas and best practices on how this essential safety and health function is developed, communicated and executed in your division.
- 3. "Lessons in Psychological Health and Safety in the Workplace" (Care for All in Education Team)

 In a follow-up to last year's introductory session to Psychological Health and Safety, the team from CFAE will be presenting a number of practical mini-lessons they have developed to help school staff work on various aspects of their psychological well-being in their workplaces. The mini-lessons are designed to be presented as part of staff meetings, wellness events, or other staff gatherings.

The training will be held from 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. Lunch will be provided at no cost to participants.
