RE: WORKPLACE SAFETY AND HEALTH TRAINING FOR SCHOOL REPS

The Manitoba Teachers' Society and the Manitoba School Boards Association have developed a one-day workshop for training employees who are WSH Committee Members or WSH representatives. Co-Chairs, Custodians, Senior Administrators, Trustees, Principals, teachers, and non-teachers (CUPE, MANTE, etc.) are encouraged to attend. The one-day workshop will cover the following three topics:

- The WSH Act & Regulations for Schools Darren Thomas (MSBA) The Manitoba WSH Act and Regulations is a lengthy document—how do committee members know what parts are the most relevant to schools? Darren Thomas will provide an overview of the legislation, highlighting the sections that arise most frequently for schools and divisions.
- 2. The Eleven Required Elements of a School/Divisional WSH Program Terri Hill (MTS) How up-to-date are your Division's WSH Policies? Are any missing? Terri will review the required "Eleven Elements" of a Divisional WSH Program.
- 3. Psychological Health and Safety (Irene Nordheim, Care For All in Education) When you think of WSH, what comes to mind? For most, it is the physical factors that may affect our health and safety at work. Irene will provide information on the benefits of having *psychologically* safe and healthy workplaces, and how to implement a Psychological Health and Safety Program for your schools and Divisions.

Lunch is provided at no cost to participants.

We would appreciate you contacting your **workplace safety and health school representatives** to advise them of the dates and to arrange for their attendance.

This workshop counts as <u>one day</u> towards the mandatory two days of Workplace Safety and Health committee member training to be funded by the employer.

- If this is the first time you are logging onto the MTS member portal to register for an event, follow all of the instructions below.
- If you have previously registered for an event through "My Profile" start with step # 4 below.
- 1. Click the "Sign Up Now" red button on the left of your screen.
- 2. Answer "Are you an MTS member?" then fill out the Registration form.
