### 2. **APPROVAL OF PREVIOUS MEETING MINUTES**

- January minutes - Lisa motion, Jenn M. second
- February minutes - Correction to next meeting date. Should read March 14, 2024. Lisa motion, Breanne second.

### 3. **SCHOOL REPORT** (see attached report)

- grade 4/5 class had presentation of marketing projects, Andrea couldn't attend, left it set up for us to view.
- Learning new sports, next week at Charleswood.
- Messaging and screen time – devices/watches, teaching about appropriateness.
  - Allison Will look into a police presentation for parents on kids and devices/screentime/online safety.
- Dealing with conflict at school. Teaching and learning social/emotional regulation. Work on it in class, transitions, throughout the day.
- Extra support plans for kids who need it.
- Playground safety monitored constantly, increased supervision. 12:15 to 12:50, 10 adults supervision, and Mrs. Ward or designate. Recess 2 supervisors, assign adults to zones, kids free play in all areas. Reports for incidents.
- EA team and supervisors report to teachers daily after recesses to keep teachers apprised of schoolyard behaviour/incidents.
- Standard of behaviour (Pembina Trails) guides responses to conflict.

### 4. **STANDING BUSINESS**

- Financials
  - 3264 in, 5030.93 out, balance 3690.55
  - Teacher appreciation cost a lot, maybe we should do a sign up for parents to bring different items. Can bring baked goods etc. Will simplify and reduce cost in future.
- Hot lunches
  - Chicken Chef – made \$1082.69
  - Try A&W next.
  - Pizza express or other pizza place after. Jen will reach out

- Could do pizza from any pizza place and hand out on plates (cheaper). Kids get tickets and line up in hallway to get their pizza. Could hand out in each classroom, or have station in each hallway to minimize carrying pizza in hallways. (could have Grades 4/5 students help)

- Fundraisers

- Archie's Pizza Fundraiser – made \$768. Went smoothly, no complaints except forgot to send food on bus with one child. Pick up was easy, hand out was outside, went well.
- Canteen made \$56.88, some kids short, other kids donated. Have one box leftover that could be returned, have 24 juice, 2 boxes chocolate (36), 40 chip bags. Will sell on movie night

MOVIE NIGHT – “Rio” – Friday April 26

- Can pre-order on hot lunch (tickets), for popcorn, chocolate bars, chips, bottled drinks & water (less spillage). \$2 each (\$1 for water)
- Allison donated a bin to store our canteen food, need to take it home at the end of school year.
- Movie night Friday, April 26. 2 showings 4:00pm and 6:30pm. Tell people doors open at 3:45pm, and 6:15 pm.
- BYOBlanket.
- Will buy brown paper bags and borrow popcorn popper for event. (look into cost of pre-packaged popcorn/butter for popper)
- Terina will make a digital poster and email to PAC for review by next week.

## 5. PREVIOUS BUSINESS

- Canteen

- Team Handball tournament coming up.
- Next year, could buy mixed boxes of individual candy packs (skittles, fuzzy peach etc.) in September or discount after Halloween, buy enough for events all year.

- June BBQ:

- Food: Will probably hire “Smoking Bobs” (Lisa will email them, check if pricing changed since last year).
  - Needs numbers approx. 1 week before.
  - Can't do gluten free buns, vegetarian option.
  - Desert bars are gluten free.
  - Lisa will ask prices.
- Vendors/Demonstrations:
  - Bouncers- consider how to manage children's sizes.
    - Big slide \$400, choose cheaper one.
    - Zip through obstacle course \$500 for 3 hours.
    - Tropical Jungle Bouncer \$200.
    - He owes us a discount from last year because he was late. Lisa will contact him.
  - Face Paint – Jen C. knows of someone, Miss Jasmine (lunch supervisor). Was sponsored by some parents last year (Kendra Blake, Royal Dance), need to price it out. Jen C. will reach out.
  - DJ (what did we decide about this?)
  - Sargent Sundae Ice Cream- Grant application

- Cookem Daisey will be at the Barbeque - will set up inside the school this year
- Glitter Tattoos – Carol Kemp (Breanne will contact).
- Discuss Oak Park Jazz Band or West Dale Cheer leaders performing (too early for Allison to email them about any performance groups). Will reach out in April.
- Give cheerleaders complimentary freezies (Jen C and (other PAC members???) have big boxes to donate).
- Discuss having Field games or Petting Zoo – can rent beanbag games etc. from the City. Decision: We don't need these. Extra cost not necessary.
- Winnipeg Police Constable and Cruiser – Kathryn sent out invite to them.
- Winnipeg Fire and Paramedics Smoke House- Application sent.
- Mascots – Boston Pizza booked already, tried calling Green Drop. Professional sports teams cost money. Last year cheapest one was \$180. Jordan (parent) has friends who have Ghost Buster outfits. Try to get them to donate their time. Lisa will ask him.
- Sponsors:
  - Equipment - Tables and chairs- ordered 28 tables and 112 chairs from Pembina Trails School Division.
    - Extension cords (covered).
    - Prizes for DJ – small toys etc. purchase from Dollarama etc. Budget was \$100 last year.
    - Need garbage and recycling bins. Reach out to Recycle Everywhere (apply online) to ask if they would donate use of divided recycle bins. Jen C. will do this.
- Set Up - Grade 4-5 students will do this.
- Trustee invitation/Superintendent invitation (give full meal). – Allison sent invitations.
- Volunteers- Estimate how many and locations.
  - (ask Trustees to volunteer).
  - Ask athletes from high school to attend in team jerseys.
- Need to call all vendors week/night before to confirm/remind.
