4.0	Principal's Report Chantal Rochan	To date: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Positive start to our school year! Students have adjusted well to the beginning of the school year. They are smiling, happy and learning. • We currently have 261 students enrolled, who are divided into 12 class grouping. • Our Indigenous collaboration mural completed in June 2023 is now a permanent part of our school in our front hallway. • “Meet the teacher” was held on Sept 5th. Once again, it was a huge success. Parent and staff feedback was positive. Great way to make initial connections with teachers and students. • We will be completing 10 fire drills this year. Our 2 lockdowns and tornado drills will take place during the colder months. • Program leaders for this year are Mme Sutherland-Brown for Literacy, Mme Iverach-Brereton for Numeracy, Mme Page for Innovation/Technology and Indigenous Perspectives and M Labossière for Well-Being. Our learning support teachers this year are Mme Dufort, Mme Acheson, and Mme Tonia (half-time). Our support team will continue to lead our staff in co-teaching initiatives this year. We appreciate their input in our school plan goals. • Teachers once again have commented how much they appreciate the Strong Beginnings days so they can build relationships with each child. • The bussing issues continue to be worked out. We thank everyone for being so understanding. Bussing challenges are stressful for families and staff alike. • We have not yet collected student fees this year. We anticipate school fees being the same as last year. All fees will be collected via Permission Click sometime in October. • Soul Sanctuary has been booked for our Holiday Concert again this year for December 13th. • Chantale Dallaire, our full-time admin secretary has moved to École Charleswood for the remainder of this school year. Sara Lopez has taken her position at École Crane and Claire Pankiw is working with us for 3 1/2 hours a day. • Rebranding Launch- We are excited to launch our new school logo and motto in the next coming weeks. An online store will be created for families to make clothing purchases with the new logo. This project has been in the works since last year and we are thrilled to begin this new journey. 			
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Upcoming:

- Cross Country runs are taking place for our grade 4 students. There are 2 more meets coming up at Crescent Park.
- Our Terry Fox walk/run will be on September 27th this year. We will be having our first school assembly before the run/walk led by M. Labossiere. Constable Bryan will join us for the assembly and assist with traffic control. Students will walk/run with their classes. Family members are invited to join us for the walk.
- This week students will be learning about Truth and Reconciliation in their classes. There will be age-appropriate discussions about the significance of this day. Our school assembly will be Friday, Sept 29th at 11:15 am. Everyone is encouraged to wear orange on Friday, September 29th.
- There is no school on Tuesday, Oct 3rd and Friday, Oct 20th. Teachers will be participating in PD that day.
- Tri-conferences will be held on the morning of October 13th and after school on the 12th (and the 17th for some teachers.)
- The afternoon of October 13th is designated as professional development for staff, and they will spend time in their program groups learning and sharing ideas on how to best support students through their program area.
- Class profiles will take place next month. This process allows for meetings with classroom teachers and support services staff so they may look at the strengths and need of each classroom and the school. With this data, we can create instructionally based actions plans.
- Picture day is October 5th. Information is being sent home this week.
