- a. School Update:
 - i. 275 students Class sizes range from 19-27
 - ii. 7 new staff hired Maria Marasco (5-8 French), Janine Zajac (Phys Ed term), Jaime Page (SST Term), Emma Heinrichs (Music term), Justen Chin (Grade 7/8), Jasmine Gilchrist (Grades 5/6), Jayden Pollock (Grades 5/6),
 - iii. New Head Custodian- William Victoria
- b. Summer & September Highlights:
 - i. Electrical upgrade has been completed
 - ii. Bulletin Boards painted Black in Hallways
 - iii. New Basketball net installed at 7/8 entrance.
 - iv. Outdoor Basketball net for grade 7/8 has been purchased and will be installed over the summer
 - v. STEM lab was turned into a 5/6 classroom & Library computers removed to make room for STEM equipment (Laptops have replaced the desktop computers)
 - vi. Meet the Teacher night on Sept 13th appeared to be a big success, with a larger attendance than last year.
 - vii. Cross country running has started with over 47 students participating
 - viii. Terry Fox Run with new coloring contest to get kids more involved in fundraising is this week
 - ix. Strong beginnings also this week. Laidlaw still piloting Edsby for scheduling.
 - x. New artwork has been purchased and hung in the office

c. School Plan:

We will be continuing with our school priority of "Environmental Inquiry" and "Numeracy". In addition there will be a focus on School Climate & Literacy

d. New Timetable Feature "Flex Time":

Laidlaw has implemented a 30 minute per day "Flex time" which asks children the question "What do you need to be successful today?" It is Flexible time in the afternoon to meet their changing needs daily. Students are given a choice on how to spend this time to either recharge or use it as a creative outlet.
