# 1. Recognition of Treaty Land

### 15.6 Transportation Start-Up Update

The Assistant Superintendent, Personnel and Education Services, provided an update to the Board with respect to challenges in Transportation start-up. He stated that of the 17,100 students in the division, 3,463 students are currently using the bus service. No routes have been canceled, and all busing requests were processed by September 9th. Moving forward, the Transportation Department will explore opportunities to encourage families to register for bus service as early as possible. The Superintendent added that communication with families is ongoing and there has been a concerted effort to use intentional language to emphasize that the new program is in the implementation stage and it's the implementation that has cause challenges, not the routing software or app.
