DESCRIPTION OF AWARDS

The Six Global Competencies

Citizenship Award:

Recognizes a student who exemplifies respect, cooperation, and leadership, consistently contributing to a more compassionate, equitable, and sustainable community.

Connection to Self Award:

Honours a student who demonstrates strong self-awareness, authenticity, and personal growth. They embrace their individuality and inspire others through resilience and reflection.

Collaboration Award:

Awarded to a student who excels in teamwork by sharing ideas, listening to others, and contributing meaningfully to group efforts.

Communication Award:

Celebrates a student with exceptional communication skills who engages with empathy, clarity, and purpose.

Creativity Award:

Presented to a student who showcases originality, imagination, and innovation across disciplines.

Critical Thinking Award:

Recognizes a student with outstanding analytical and problem-solving abilities who questions assumptions and contributes to a thoughtful, inquisitive learning culture.



DESCRIPTION OF AWARDS



The Circle of Courage

Mastery Award:

Honours a student who demonstrates deep dedication to learning and mastery of complex subjects. Their passion and perseverance set a high standard for academic excellence. This award also includes an achievement of at least 90% in 4 or more 40S courses, including ELA and Math.

Generosity Award:

Awarded to a student who shows kindness and selflessness through their consistent support of others, both within and beyond the school community.

Independence Award:

Celebrates a student who exhibits strong initiative, self-reliance, and decision-making. They tackle challenges and serve as a role model for responsibility.

Belonging Award:

Given to a student who fosters a strong sense of community by embracing diversity and ensuring everyone feels seen, supported, and included.

Trailhawk Award

This award is given to a student who demonstrates grit and perseverance. They exemplify gratitude and take the idea of reimagining pathways to the next level.

Ambassador Award

This prestigious award honours a student who embodies all six Global Competencies, leading by example through initiative, leadership, and excellence. They are a true role model and the embodiment of PTC's values.
