

SAFE GRAD RULES & REGULATIONS 2026

1. Admission to the Safe Grad Party is limited to graduates and one paid invited guest. Supervisors at the door will have a list of approved graduates and guests. No one will be allowed in without their name being on the attendee list.
2. No one under the age of 16 or over 21 may attend the Safe Grad Party.
3. All graduates and guests will be provided with a wristband identifying whether the person is of legal age or not. **Photo ID is required:** only Manitoba Liquor and Lotteries sanctioned forms of ID will be accepted. **(Valid Driver's License, Passport, Manitoba Identification Card)**
4. Only 18+ wrist-banded people may purchase alcohol. Bar service is restricted to the purchase of two drinks at a time. It is illegal to purchase alcoholic beverages for minors and will not be permitted and Venue staff, at their discretion, may refuse to serve anyone who has "had too much to drink."
5. Those with 18+ wristbands must always carry their ID at the party. They will be required to show their ID as they enter to the venue, and staff may request to see ID at any time during the event.
6. Graduates are responsible for their own and their guests' behavior. If the graduate leaves, his/her guest must also leave. However, if the guest leaves, the graduate may stay.
7. Everyone, regardless of how much he/she has or has not had to drink, will be driven home by his/her Designated Driver. If the graduate and/or guest wish to leave early, the Designated Driver will be notified to pick them up, and they may not return. Designated Drivers must be 21 years of age or older.
8. No alcohol or drugs may be brought into the Safe Grad venue. No entry will be permitted to anyone who appears intoxicated. All graduates and guests are subject to bag and pocket checks at entry.
9. The RBC Convention Centre requires all Safe Grad attendees to be in semi-formal/formal attire. This applies to both dinner and the safe grad party. Changing out of formal attire is not permitted. Small personal bags (e.g., purses) are permitted; however, large bags or bags containing a change of clothes will not be allowed. Only a change of shoes may be brought into the venue.
10. Doors open at 9pm and all attendees must be picked up by 2:00am.
11. Any person involved in a fight or any other aggressive physical or verbal behavior, either as an instigator or retaliator, will be sent home. Their designated driver will be notified to pick them up immediately.
12. There will be food served throughout the night.
13. Non-alcoholic drinks (pop and water) will always be available.
14. Graduates and guests must adhere to the conditions outlined in the Photos/Videos Agreement and the Drinking and Pre-Gaming Agreement that was signed prior to the Safe Grad event.
15. Medical assistance will be provided if required, and parents or guardians may be contacted in the event of illness, injury, or safety concerns; emergency services will be contacted if necessary.
